1.CODE OF CONDUCT

1.1 Rules

This document outlines the rules and regulations pertaining to the Porsche Challenge Tournament at NXNE's Game Land. Failing to adhere to these rules and regulations may result in disqualification from the competition. Please note that both Waveform Entertainment and NXNE has the authority to make final decisions that are not specifically delineated in these rules and regulations to preserve fair play and sportsmanship.

1.1.1 All ejections or disqualifications due to violations of the Code of Conduct or individual game rules will be without refund.

1.1.2 No illegal substances inside the venue. Getting caught with these items or evidence of the presence of these items will result in disqualification from the event and eviction from the venue.

1.1.3 No fighting or weaponry inside the venue. Throwing controllers or acting in a way that could pose a danger to other players will result in disqualification from the event and eviction from the venue.

1.1.4 NXNE (North by Northeast) and Waveform Entertainment are referred to hereafter as TOs (Tournament Organizers)

1.1.5 No refusal to play on certain setups barring extreme circumstances. All players agree to have their matches recorded if requested by the TOs.

1.1.6 All disqualifications due to tardiness will be complete DQs, meaning the disqualified player will be removed from both winners and losers bracket, or removed from the entire event if late for a pools match.

1.1.7 The TO are granted license to any and all types of video that you may be present at the event, including camera recordings, livestream broadcasts, and captured gameplay footage.

1.1.8 The TO are granted license to photograph your image, likeness, or depiction at the event, and you waive any claim for compensation for the event's use or publication of photographs taken of you.

1.1.9 The TO reserve the right to deny entry into the tournament to any player suspected of committing anything considered a crime or acting in a manner that is detrimental to the integrity of the event.

1.1.10 The TO reserve the right to deny payout from event winnings to any player suspected of intentionally throwing a match, splitting a payout, cheating, or committing any other form of bracket manipulation.

1.1.11 The TO reserve the right to settle any unforeseen situations that may occur, and his judgment is final. In extreme situations, rules may be altered between phases of a tournament in the best interests of the event.

1.1.12 The TO are not responsible for any lost or stolen items from the Gaming Garage room.

2.Registration and Check-in

2.1 Eligibility

In order to be eligible for a tournament, you must first register. Before you register it is your responsibility to make sure that you are:

2.1.1 Residually eligible (*able to attend Game Land*) and resident of Canada or the United States

2.1.2 In compliance with the age restriction (*14-17 with parental consent or +18*)

2.2 Check-in

2.2.1 After checking in competitors will be directed to their game station.

2.3 Acknowledgement

2.3.1 By participating in Game Land you acknowledge you have read all rules and agree to the terms and conditions.

3.Forza Motorsport 7 Rules

3.1 Rules

3.1.1 Players must be registered on smash.gg/NXNEForza and the waveform events discord : <https://discord.gg/35GYuhJ>

3.1.2 At the discretion of the Administrator, any Game that is played in full will not be open for review and the results will be considered final

3.1.3 If the Host disconnects from a race before at least one Entrant has completed the first lap, the race will be restarted with the original grid placements

3.1.4 If the Host disconnects from a race after at least one Entrant has completed the first lap, the race will continue to completion

3.1.5 If an Entrant disconnects from a race prior to its completion they will not be eligible to re-join and will not earn points for that race.

3.1.6 The Administrator reserves the right to broadcast any Race of the Tournament, at its sole discretion. If Administrator chooses to broadcast a Race, Administrator will choose to either: (a) host each individual Race, and all participating Entrants must join that Race; or (b) join a Race that's being hosted by a participating Entrant.

3.1.7 The Live Qualifiers will take place in the NXNE Game Land at Stackt.

3.1.8 Before submitting a lap time on-site during the Live Qualifiers all Entrants must complete the registration form provided by the Administrator

3.1.9 All qualifying laps must be clean, as determined by the game. Dirty laps will not be counted.

3.1.10 In the event that a qualified Entrant is unable to participate in the Grand Finals or is disqualified or found to be ineligible by the Administrator a replacement may be determined, at the discretion of the Administrator, by selecting the next fastest Entrant in the corresponding Qualifying Period during the Live Qualifiers.

4. Forza Motorsport 7 Format

4.1 Tournament format

4.1.1 The Tournament will be run in three stages.

4.1.2 **Stage One (Online Qualifiers)** : Players will have a chance for two (2) weeks each featuring a new track every week. Online qualifiers will take place May 25 and June 1. Players can submit their fastest lap time via screenshot **in the Waveform Events discord** : <https://discord.gg/35GYuhJ>. The top two competitors with the fastest lap time each week will move on to compete at the Grand Finals on June 9, 2019 at GAMELAND presented by NXNE at Stackt. After confirmation of placement, online qualified players will have their flight and hotel covered to compete in the Grand Finals in Toronto on June 9th. *NOTE: Flight will include one round trip ticket and two nights stay in Toronto (June 8 & 9)*

4.1.2 Stage Two (Live Qualifiers) : Players will have the chance to compete LIVE at NXNE Game Land on June 7th and 8th for a chance to enter the Grand Finals on June 9th, 2019. Qualification is open exclusively to attendees at Game Land during the day. Each day will feature a new track. Players will be able to submit their times to the onsite Forza Motorsport 7 Game Land Admin. Four spots in the finals are up for grabs. Two on June 7th and two on June 8th.

4.1.2 Stage Three (Live Finals) : The Forza 7 Motorsport GAMESLAND Grand Finals will feature the top 4 finalists from the open online qualifier and the top 4 finalists from the open live qualifier. Each finalist will be assigned to one of two heats, based on their qualifying results. Each heat will feature a race of several pre-selected tracks, with points awarded to competitors based on the final results of each individual race. The four competitors with the most points from each Semifinal heat will race in a final heat for the Championship race. Entrants will have ten minutes before the start of each practice session to login and setup, and ensure their console, controller, and headset are working properly, and an additional five-minute break between Races 1 and 2. Time limits will begin immediately after the end of the preceding Heat. All time limits will be strictly enforced. Any Entrant that is not ready to start at the designated time may be disqualified from the race at the discretion of the Administrator, and will not be eligible to earn points for that race.

4.2 Game Settings

Game Mode = Rivals Event

Suggested Line = Off

Braking = ABS Off

Steering = Normal

Traction Control = Off

Stability Control = Off

Shifting = Automatic (no restrictions)

Damage, Fuel & Tire Wear = Cosmetic

Rewind = On

Friction Assist = Off

4.2.2 Online Qualifiers Settings

Online Qualifying Periods (Track – Car – Date) – Each Qualifying Period will be open from 10:00 AM PT on the first day of that period, to 11:59 PM PT on the last day of that period:

Online Qualifier 1 - May 25, 2019

- Road America; Conditions: No Weather – 2018 Porsche 911 GT2 RS

Online Qualifier 2 - June 1st, 2019

- Sebring; Conditions: No Weather – 2018 Porsche 911 GT2 RS

4.2.3 Live Qualifiers Settings

Live Qualifying Periods (Track – Car – Date) – Each Qualifying Period will be open from 10:00 AM ET on the first day of that period, to 9:59 PM ET on the last day of that period, on site at the Game Land venue Stackt:

Qualifier 1 - June 7, 2019

- Virginia International Raceway; Conditions: No Weather - 2018 Porsche 911 GT2 RS

Qualifier 2 - June 8, 2019

- Road America; Conditions: No Weather – 2018 Porsche 911 GT2 RS

4.2.3 Grand Finals

The Grand Finals event will consist of a two-stage live tournament to be held on June 9th, 2019, at Stackt. The Grand Finals will consist of Four (4) Finalists that qualified during the Online Qualifiers and the four (4) that qualified during the Live Qualifiers.

During Stage 1, the 16 Finalists will be divided into four (4) Heats of two (2), and each Heat will participate in two (2) individual races. Points will be assigned to Finalists based on the final results of each individual race, and the top Finalist from each Heat, based on their total accumulated points, will be will qualify for Stage 2 (4 in total).

During Stage 2, the remaining Finalists will participate in two (2) individual races. Points will be assigned to Finalists based on the final results of each individual race, and their total accumulated points after both races will determine their final placing in the Tournament.

4.3 MATCH OUTCOME

4.3.1 Before submitting a lap time during the Online Qualifiers, each Entrant must register for the Tournament on smash.gg/NXNEForza.

5.Prizing

5.1 Prizing

- 1st Place - \$1,000 plus two spots at the Porsche Track Experience and a Herschel Carry-on Luggage (Total value of prize is \$5,550)
- 2nd Place - \$600 plus one spot at the Porsche Track Experience and a Herschel backpack (Total value of prize is \$2,900)
- 3rd Place - \$400 plus one spot at the Porsche Track Experience and a Herschel hip pack (Total value of prize is \$2,640)
